Pool Safety Guidelines

- No Outside Food or Drink Permitted
- Appropriate Swim Wear Only
- All State and Local Health Codes Apply
- Staff May Refuse Entry if Necessary
- Aquatic Toys or Floats Are Not Permitted
- Please Walk At All Times
- No Horseplay Please
- U.S. Coast Guard Approved Flotation Devices Only
- Non Toilet Trained Children Must Wear Swim Diaper

Supervision of Children

- Parents or guardians ***MUST*** be responsible for supervising their children.
- Lifeguards are responsible for enforcing the safety rules and responding to emergency situations.
- Children 10 and under must be accompanied by a chaperone at least 16 years of age.

Policies Regarding Unscheduled Closing of Aquatic Facility

1. The pool will be cleared for a period of 15 minutes anytime lightning is spotted or thunder is heard. Patrons will be allowed to re-enter the pool once the time has elapsed without reoccurrence of thunder or lightning. If stormy conditions continue, the pool will be closed for the day.
2. When a situation arises that would jeopardize public health or safety of the people in attendance. According to Illinois Health code guests must be asked to clear the pool any time there is vomiting or fecal accident in the water. The pool will be cleared for a period of 15 minutes while chemical adjustments are made.
3. When the air temperature falls below 70 degrees Fahrenheit for a continuous one hour period, the pool will close for the day.
4. If there are 10 or less swimmers for a one-hour period and poor weather conditions exist, the pool will close for the day.

**Refunds will not be given if the pool closes due to inclement weather for any period of time.*
